What will I learn next week.....

Religion: We will begin Chapter 23, the Church Lives Today. We will talk about the important people who lead our Church. Our class will be in charge of our first Mass next week on Wednesday. I have already handed out the readings and I hope you have been practicing. We will continue to practice at school as well. If you did not get a part this time, please do not worry. We will have plenty of opportunities this year!

Math: We will continue working on adding three digit numbers with regrouping. There are so many steps in these problems we have to be careful and make sure we check our work. Keep working on your addition facts!

Reading: We will read two stories "Ah, Music" and "There's a Hole at the Bottom of the Sea." As we read we will work on our comprehension skills. We will work on text and graphic features as well as fact and opinion. There will also be new high frequency words to learn and we will discuss some new vocabulary words. Our Spelling words are words with vowel digraphs ai and ay.

English: We will learn about compound sentences. This will help us to add detail to our sentences and make them more complex. We will also begin the steps in the writing process to make our own Young Author stories. This will

be done in class.

Social Studies/Science: We will learn about the Scientific Method. We will learn the process Scientists go through to conduct an experiment and we will do some experiments of our own.
