What will I learn next week.....

Religion: We will begin Chapter 24, We Pray. We will talk about important prayers in our lives and learn why prayer is so essential to our everyday life.

Math: We will wrap up our chapter on three-digit addition with regrouping. I am so proud of how far we have come. Everyone really understands this concept and they are working so hard to solve these problems. We will then start our chapter on three-digit subtraction. This gets a little trickier so we will make sure we check our work for silly mistakes.

Reading: We will read two stories, "Schools Around the World" and "An American School." As we read we will work on our comprehension skills. We will work on text and graphic features as well as main idea and details. There will also be new high frequency words to learn and we will discuss some new vocabulary words. Our Spelling words are words with vowel digraphs ee and ea.

English: We will learn about quotation marks. Be prepared to see these all over our work as we start to learn when it is correct to use them in our

writing. We will also talk about opinion writing.

Social Studies/Science: We will learn conduct an experiment on M & M's. We will be comparing and contrasting a small snack size bag to a large size bag. We will follow the step of the Scientific Method and will collect our data like a real scientist. When our experiment is complete we will get to enjoy some M & M's as a snack.
