What will I learn next week.....

Religion: We will begin Chapter 6, The Church Year. We will discuss how the Church year is made up of seasons. We will talk about how important it is to meet with our Parish community weekly and on special days during the year.

Math: We will continue Chapter 2, Number Patterns. We will begin by learning how to skip count on hundred charts. We will be focusing on skip counting by 2's, 5's and 10's.

Reading: We will read two stories, "Diary of a Spider" and "A Swallow and a Spider." We will learn the reading skills cause/effect, figurative language and how to summarize. We will be introduced to some new high frequency words as well as new vocabulary words. Our Spelling words review long vowel sounds o, u, e and sounds for g. Our spelling test will be on THURSDAY this week since we will not be in school on Friday

English: During English we will be talking about nouns. We will play some games and be on the lookout all week for nouns around us. We will also be working on how to write a friendly letter.
