What will I learn next week.....

Religion: We will begin Chapter 3 and talk about how we belong to the Catholic Church. We will discuss the Seven Sacraments and start to make ourselves very familiar with the two we will be receiving this year, First Reconciliation and First Communion.

Math: We will continue working on subtraction by comparing adding to subtraction and finding missing addends. We will also work on fact families. Keep practicing your facts!

Reading/English: We will read a story called, "My Family." We will also read some family poetry. As we read we will learn new skills that include: compare/contrast and questioning. Our spelling list will be words with short vowels o, u and e sounds. These words are on our class website under the spelling tab. Pretest on Monday.

In English we will learn more about writing simple sentences. We will review subjects and predicates and use them in our own writing. We will also be discussing how to write a friendly letter.

Social Studies/Science: In second grade our Theme time will be used for Social Studies and Science. We will spend a couple weeks on one subject and then switch to the other. This week we will start Science and we will be talking about matter. We will learn new words like solids, liquids and gases.
