

We had another successful week! We went to Church for Ash Wednesday and started our Lenten journey, read a new story, learned about graphs and ended our week with Stations of the Cross. Next week will be just as busy with no school on Monday!

What will I learn next week.....

Religion: We will complete Chapter 17, We Celebrate the Liturgy of the Word. We are beginning the chapters that will prepare us for First Communion. Everyone is very excited as we prepare for this special time in their life.

Math: We will continue to talk about graphs. We will be learning how graphs can help us to organize information. We will learn how to make different types of graphs to display our information.

Reading: We will read two stories, "Luke Goes to Bat" and "Jackie Robinson." As we read we will work on our comprehension skills. We will also work on sequence of event and formal/informal language. There will be new high frequency words to learn and we will discuss some new vocabulary words. Our Spelling words will be words with long i sounds (i, igh, ie, y). The test will be on Friday.

English: We will learn about subject-verb agreement. We will discuss how we need to use the correct form of the verb to match the subject of a sentence. We will also talk about adding -es to certain verbs that end in s, sh, ch, tch, z or x.

Social Studies/Science: During Theme time we have started talking about land forms and water. We will continue our discussion next week and we will talk about how land changes over time and even get to see some fossils.
