### What will I learn next week.....

**Religion:** We will work on Chapter 19, We Go in Peace to Share God's Love. We will be learning about the last part of Mass. We will talk about the blessings and prayers that are shared during this part of the Mass.

**Math:** We will continue our chapter on clocks. We will be learning about the minute and hour hand and how to tell time in five minute intervals. We will also talk about A.M. and P.M.

We will also work on point of view and finding the text and graphic features. There will be new high frequency words to learn and we will discuss new vocabulary words. Our Spelling words will be words with *ar*. The test will be on Friday.

English: We will learn how to put commas in dates and places. We will review Capital letters, quotation marks and commas in a booklet about our school. We will also talk about organizing our writing by having a beginning, middle and end.

Social Studies/Science: We will continue to work on Studies Weekly packets. We will be learning about Rights and Responsibilities and Scientist and Inventors.
