### What will I learn next week.....

**Religion:** In Religion class we will work on Chapter 18, we celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist. We will continue to learn about the Mass as we prepare ourselves for making our First Communion.

**Math:** We will wrap up our chapter on graphs and move to telling time. We will be learning about analog and digital clocks, the minute/hour hands and how to tell time in five minute intervals. Daily practice of these concepts will help us quickly learn how to read an analog clock.

**Reading:** We will read two stories, "My Name is Gabriela" and "Poems about Reading and Writing." As we read we will work on our comprehension skills. We will also work on understanding characters and author's word choice. There will be new high frequency words to learn and we will discuss new vocabulary words. Our Spelling

words will be words with the long e sound for y and changing y to i.  
The test will be on Friday.

English: We will learn about the Verb Be. We will talk about how *was/were* are also forms and how they tell us about something that has happened in the past.

Social Studies/Science: During Theme time we work on our Social Study Weekly brochures.
